## Uvalde Hospice

### What is Hospice?

Hospice is a type and philosophy of care provided by a team of health care professionals who maximize comfort for a person with a life limiting illness by reducing pain and addressing physical, psychological, social, and spiritual needs. Hospice aims to bring comfort, self-respect, and tranquility to people nearing the end of life.

Hospice care focuses on two main goals:

relieving pain and symptoms and providing support and care to the patient and family.

Uvalde Hospice cares for all patients regardless of their ability to pay. Our Social Services department works with patients to find financial resources when necessary.

Hospice is reimbursed by Medicare, Medicaid, and most private insurance.
